
Central Garrett T-Ball Guidelines

- A game consists of three innings.
- The away team at-bat half of the inning is played first.
- All players on each team bat in each inning of play.
- All players on each team play a defensive field position in each inning of play.
- When a team bats through the batting order once, the team's at-bat half of the inning is over.
- A batter hits off a batting tee and may swing as many times as needed to hit a fair ball.
- There are no strikes or balls.
- The batter may optionally receive three coach pitches per bat. If the batter is unable to hit a thrown ball into play, a ball is placed on the tee and the player continues until a fair ball is hit.
- After the ball is successfully put into play, the batter will run to reach first base safely.
- A base runner will advance one additional base once when a subsequent batter hits a fair ball.
- The last batter in the batting order may circle the bases to finish the inning after the ball is hit in play.
- There are no outs, but the fielders are encouraged to field the ball in an attempt to make an out.
- The T-ball division is non-competitive so scores and statistics are not recorded.
